Grading

The grading criteria is as follows:

Pass=at least 70% Fail = less than 70%

60% = performance on the RAM Prep curriculum for the specific grade level

40% = weekly attendance/participation (doing your homework, staying on task, and making the most of the time we have in class).

<u>Note:</u> All assignments must be turned in on time for credit. There are no exceptions! You have at least two weeks for each assignment so ahead and turn it in early. If for some reason you are sick on the day it is due that is not an excuse...TURN IT IN EARLY!!

<u>Seniors:</u> You have the option of earning the principal award of distinction. In order to earn this award you must complete a senior project and 50 hours of community service. Your project must be approved by Mrs. Teske by Sept 30th and you must be completed with your project by March 1st. In order to graduate you must complete a portfolio and have an exit interview with your Ram Prep teacher and one other teacher (TBD).
